Travel Information

Arriving in Beijing

Beijing is served by two major international airports:

Beijing Capital International Airport (PEK)

Located northeast of the city center, PEK remains one of Asia's busiest international hubs and offers direct connections to most major cities in Asia, Europe, North America, Oceania, and the Middle East.

Beijing Daxing International Airport (PKX)

The newer international airport, designed by the renowned architect Zaha Hadid, is one of the world's most modern airport facilities and serves an increasing number of international and domestic routes.

Both airports are connected to Beijing's extensive public transportation network. Delegates may reach the Fragrant Hill (Xiangshan: 香山) area using combinations of airport express trains, metro lines, and light rail services. Public transportation stations are located within walking distance of the Fragrant Hill Hotel and the eastern entrance of Fragrant Hills Park.

Taxi and ride-sharing services are readily available at both airports. Depending on traffic conditions, the expected cost of a taxi ride to the hotel is typically **below USD \$30**.

Venue Location

Fragrant Hill Hotel (Xiangshan Hotel)

Haidian District, Beijing, China

The hotel is located within the scenic Fragrant Hills Park area in northwestern Beijing and provides an integrated environment for scientific sessions, accommodations, meals, networking activities, and outdoor recreation.

Combining RegPep26 with Other Scientific Activities in China

Participants interested in extending their visit to China may wish to consider attending the:

Cold Spring Harbor Asia Conference on Neurobiology of Mental Health
March 29 – April 2, 2027
Suzhou, China

The conference begins immediately following RegPep26, making it possible to attend both meetings during a single trip.

Suzhou is located approximately 100 km west of Shanghai and is one of China's most historically important cities, with a history extending more than 2,500 years. Often referred to as the "**Silk Capital of China**" and the "**Venice of the East**," Suzhou is internationally known for its classical gardens, canals, lakes, traditional architecture, and vibrant modern scientific and technological development.

Travel between Beijing and Suzhou is straightforward. More than 100 high-speed trains operate daily between the two cities. Travel time is typically **4–5 hours**, with standard fares generally around **USD \$80**.

For colleagues traveling long distances to China, the combination of RegPep26 in Beijing and the Cold Spring Harbor Asia Conference in Suzhou may provide an especially rewarding scientific and cultural experience.
